

RESOLUTION FOR REFERENDUM

WHEREAS, the City Council having heretofore ordered notice to be published weekly for four successive weeks in the Fayetteville Observer that, at its meeting at 8:00 o'clock P. M. on the 22nd day of May, 1961, it would consider the annexation of the territory contiguous to the City of Fayetteville, hereinafter described, which notice was so published, and,

WHEREAS, at said meeting a petition was filed and signed by at least fifteen per cent of the qualified voters resident in the area proposed to be annexed requesting a referendum on the question, and the City Council having determined the election will be conducted solely in the area proposed to be annexed;

AND WHEREAS at said meeting on said date, said City Council resolved to request the Board of Elections of Cumberland County to call said election, and now wishes to make formal and full resolution of such request to said Board of Elections;

THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE DO RESOLVE:

That the Board of Elections of Cumberland County is respectfully ordered to call an election, as by statute provided, to determine whether or not there shall be annexed to the City of Fayetteville the territory contiguous thereto and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the western margin of Raleigh Road, said point being where the southern boundary of the Greene Park Subdivision intersects with the western margin of Raleigh Road; and running thence southerly with the western margin of Raleigh Road and the present city limits to the Second Spring Branch, which Branch is the present city limit line; thence with the Second Spring Branch and the city limit line westerly crossing Rose Hill Road to the point at which the Second Spring Branch empties into Big Cross Creek, said point being a corner in the present city limit line; and running thence along a new boundary northwardly with the course of Big Cross Creek to the point where Big Cross Creek intersects a line which runs parallel and 150 ft. to the West of the western margin of Rose Hill Road; thence along said parallel line 150 ft. West of Rose Hill Road northwestwardly to the southern property line of the Elwood Benton property as described in Book 688, Page 107 of the Cumberland County Registry; thence with said Benton line easterly to the western margin of Rose Hill Road; thence with the western margin of Rose Hill Road northwesterly crossing Country Club Drive to the northwestern corner of Rose Hill Road and Country Club Drive; thence with the northern margin of Country Club Drive crossing Rose Hill Road eastwardly to the southwestern corner of Lot Number 1 Country Club Acres as recorded in Plat Book 14, Page 69 of the Cumberland Co. Registry; and running thence with the western property line of Lot Number 1 North 2 degrees 39 minutes East to the northwestern corner of Lot Number 1; and running thence South 87 degrees 21 minutes East 825 feet along the rear boundaries of Lots 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, 15, 17, 19 and 21 of Country Club Acres to the northeastern corner of Lot Number 21; and running thence North 2 degrees 39 minutes East 150 feet with the western margin of Lot Number 24 Country Club Acres to the northwestern corner of Lot Number 24; and running thence South 87 degrees 21 minutes East 133.5 feet to the northeastern corner of Lot 24 Country Club Acres, said point being in the western margin of Greene Park Subdivision; and running thence with the western margin of Greene Park Subdivision North 15 degrees 52 minutes East 594.2 feet to a corner in said Greene Park Subdivision and running thence with the northern boundary of Greene Park Subdivision South 63 degrees 36 minutes East 941.43 feet to a corner in the northern boundary of Greene Park Subdivision; and running thence with the northern boundary of the Greene Park Subdivision 78 degrees 9 minutes East 208.36 feet to the northeastern corner of Lot Number 22 Greene Park Subdivision; and running thence with the eastern boundary of Lots 22 and 21 of Greene Park Subdivision crossing Country Club Dr. South 3 degrees 50 minutes East 845.8 feet to the southeastern corner of Lot Number 21 Greene Park Subdivision; and running thence with the southern margin of the Greene Park Subdivision and the southern boundaries of Lots 19, 17, 15, 13, 11, 9, 7, 5, 3 and 1 to the beginning.

A special meeting of the City Council was held to award bids for the year 1961-1962 for new tires and tubes, recapping, and batteries. Also for gasoline, oils and greases, anti-freeze, diesel fuel and fuel oil. Representatives from the various bidding firms were also present.

After examination and discussion of the bids as submitted by the City Manager, the Council accepted the following bids:

Motion by Councilman Rose, seconded by Councilman Plummer, and unanimously approved, to Cities Service Oil Company for gasoline at .192 per gallon.

Motion by Councilman Plummer, seconded by Councilman Rose, and unanimously approved, to Pure Oil Company for combined bid on oils and greases of \$1,653.16.

Motion by Councilman Maness, seconded by Councilman Rhodes, and unanimously approved, to Gulf Oil Company for anti-freeze at \$1.55 per gallon.

Motion by Councilman Plummer, seconded by Councilman Maness, and unanimously approved, to Cities Service Oil Company for diesel fuel at .1079 per gallon.

Motion by Councilman Maness, seconded by Councilman Rose, and unanimously approved, to Pure Oil Company for #2 heating oil at .1154 per gallon.

Motion by Councilman Rhodes, seconded by Councilman Plummer, and unanimously approved, to General Tire Company for new tires and tubes.

Motion by Councilman Plummer, seconded by Councilman Maness, and unanimously approved, to Todd Tire Service for recapping.

Motion by Councilman Maness, seconded by Councilman Rose, and unanimously approved, to Corder-Vossler for batteries.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:15 P. M.
